Ontario's spending growth is also well in excess of any other provincial government, among those who have tabled budgets so far this year.

Considering the Rae government has also downloaded at least \$541 million of its deficits to transfer payment receipts such as municipalities, it's not much to boast about.

Of particular interest is what isn't on the table, at least on budget day: The Minimum Corporate Tax. The budget speech refers to it only as a matter for further study, which will result in a "technical paper" later this fall, and can only aggravate business uncertainty and investor wariness between know and then.
