

# Rosspport group taking over dock

Fisheries and Oceans has entered into a lease with the Rosspport Area Conservation and Development Group (RACDG) for management of the Government Dock in Rosspport.

The RACDG has approved a four member group to serve as the Rosspport Dock Committee (RDC) on their behalf. This group is comprised of Rose Marie Renaud, Alison Collins, Dave Tamblyn and Jim Van den Ende.

Previously, Van den Ende ran the dock himself, says committee member Rose Marie Renaud.

"And he gave it up, so the RACDG took it over, representing the people of Rosspport," she says.

The objective of the RDC is to carry out the rules and regulations of the lease, as well as

to work toward obtaining services required at the dock and the surrounding area.

The RDC has approached Fisheries and Oceans with a list of requirements, including: a pump out; wheelchair accessibility to floating dock; a water line; public washrooms; a garbage facility; upgrading of electrical systems; improved lighting; maintenance to the Fisheries and Oceans building; and supplies for landscaping.

"We don't know what they're going to cost yet, we just know what we want," says Rose Marie Renaud.

Making the Rosspport Dock and the surrounding area look more inviting will be beneficial not only for attracting tourists, but for the local residents as well. The RDC is planning to have picnic tables on the dock, and hopes to have an area for

benches and flower pots as well. The day to day running of the dock will be handled by a dock attendant, who will be responsible for collecting launching fees and for general maintenance.

Two parking areas will provide boaters with somewhere to park their vehicles and trail-

ers after launching.

Funds will also be used to assist the Rosspport Park Planning Committee to develop the existing Wardrope Park. This park is located across from the Rosspport Fish Derby site.

"In Wardrope Park, we have already ordered the playground equipment, and we are putting in new holding tanks for the washrooms," says Renaud.

"We've also got \$2,000 from the Ministry of Natural Resources for a bird-viewing platform with interpretive plaques. It's under the Community Wildlife Involvement Project."
