Crimestoppers kept up the pressure though, forging ahead to 10-4 at the top of the fifth inning.

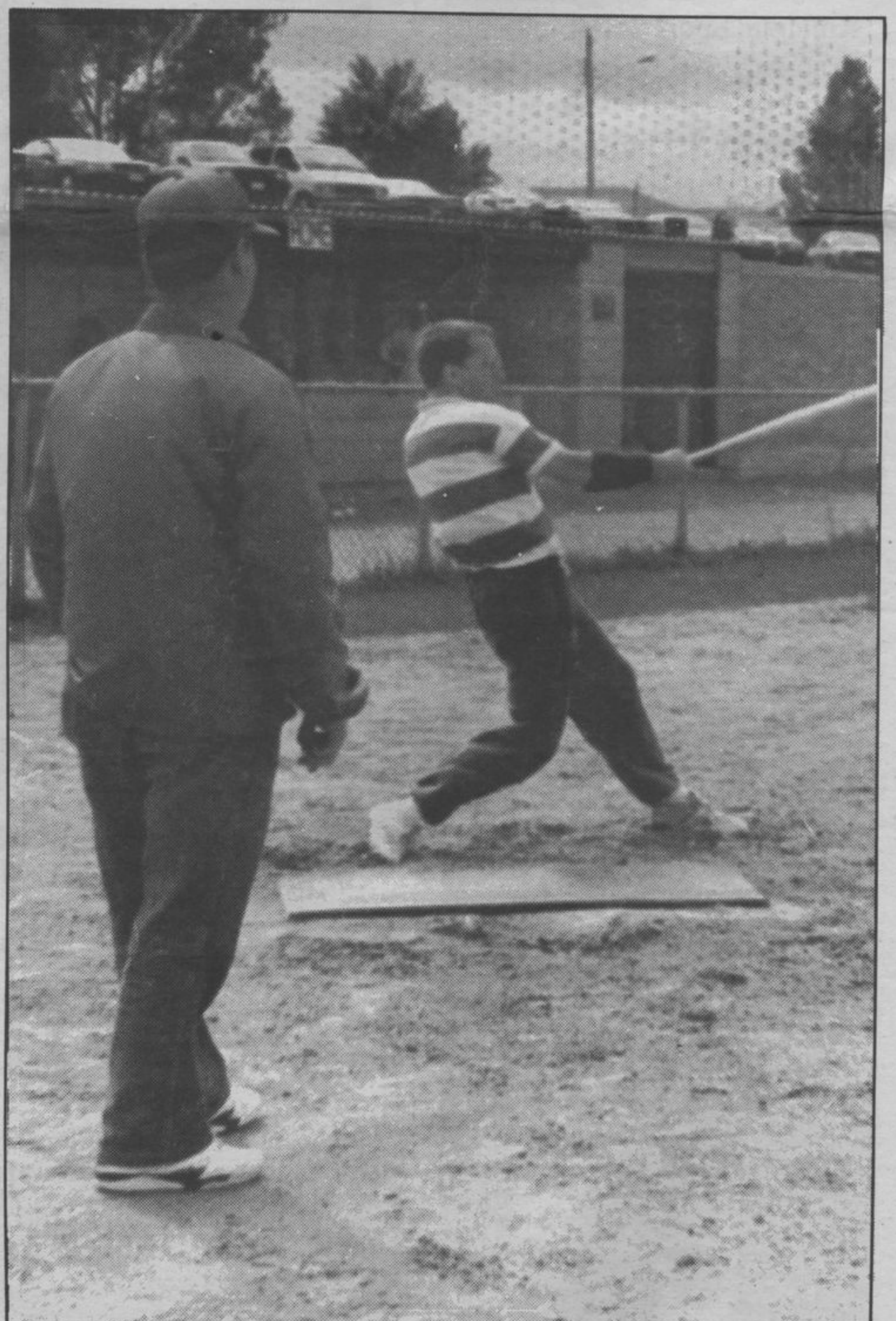
Stompers rallied once again, putting up three more runs, continued on page 3
