teacher asked her name. Keith had to find out about Heather's problems and a less serious medical problem of his son Ben through second hand sources, even though the terms of their agreement requires Lisa to keep Keith up to date on the "medical, psychological, and educational health" of the children.

Frustrated by the denial of his rights and unable to afford any further court actions,

Keith's only recourse was to withhold support payments. He says he "could afford to visit once a month, or the support payments, but not both. I decided my relationship with the kids was more important."

But now that the provincial government is garnisheeing his paycheque, what recourse does he have? What tribunal can he appeal to? Keith sees it this way: "Women can walk away and know the system has flip-flopped, from where guys got everything and women had no rights, the pendulum's gone the other way

and there's no recourse, other than paying lots of money to lawyers to go back to court. I can't afford that."

Keith wants a system of annual or bi-annual reviews, preferably before the same judge that heard the original divorce case.
