

# Show Choir's "All That Jazz"

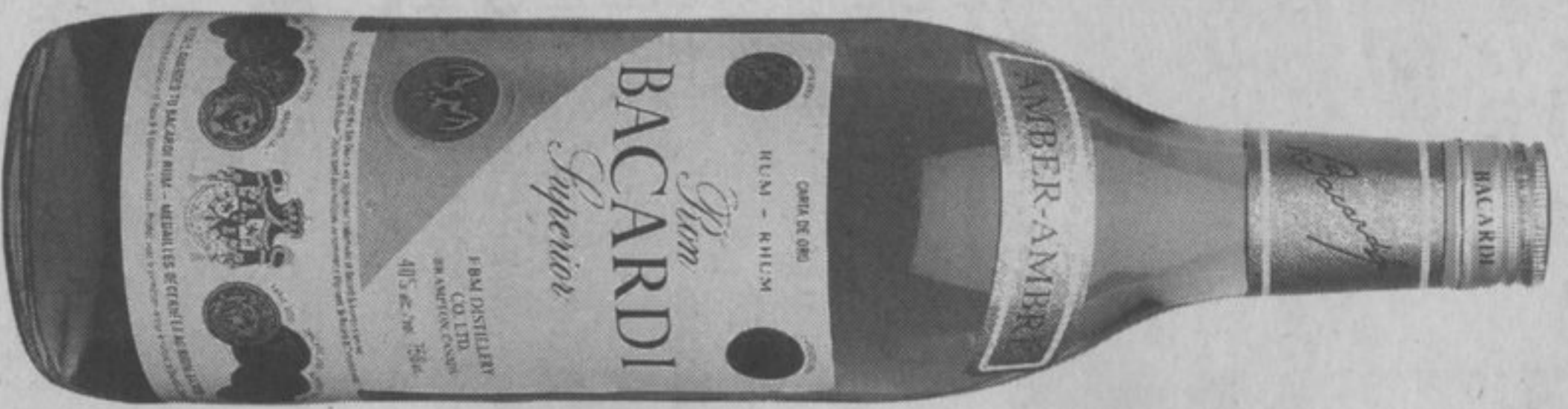
