Conservation officers struggling

Although they're celebrating their 100th anniversary this year, Ontario's once proud conservation officers have been effectively hamstringed by cutbacks that often force them to ignore poaching and habitat destruction.

And as a result, Ontario's fish and wildlife resources are facing the biggest threat in the province's history, according to the Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH). Conservation officers across Ontario have expressed outrage that cutbacks have compro-

mised their dedication to protect the natural environment.

Most recently, Ontario's cabinet decided to slash 55 per cent of the officers' annual operating budget in southern Ontario, forcing many of them to cancel patrols and ignore some calls relating to poaching and habitat destruction.

The financial crisis has forced the Ontario Conservation Officers Association (OCCOA) to launch a public campaign against the government, pleading with people to tell Premier Bob Rae that funding decisions be reversed.

"Conservation officers everywhere rely heavily on public cooperation to effectively safe guard our wildlife," states a Sept. 10 news release from the OCCOA. "If an officer can't help you this fall, don't blame the officer."

"The OCCOA is saying many of the things we've been telling the government for years," said Rick Morgan, OFAH executive vice president. "Since 1986, the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources, which is responsible for conservation officers, hasn't received enough to cover

Township were replaced.

Once all the work is completed, Estie says a review of lighting levels will take place to ensure that the lighting level is uniform.

The Ontario Hydro grant is through its Street-Smart Lighting program. Through the program, Hydro is aiming at helping municipalities replace 500,000 streetlights by 1994, saving a total of 42,000 kilowatts of power.

Thus far, 84,061 lights have been converted at a total cost to Hydro of \$4.5 million.
