Most recently, Ontario's cabinet decided to slash 55 per cent of the officers' annual operating budget in southern Ontario, forcing many of them to cancel patrols and ignore some calls relating to poaching and habitat destruction.

The financial crisis has forced the Ontario Conservation Officers Association (OCOA) to launch a public campaign against the government, pleading with people to tell Premier Bob Rae that funding decisions be reversed.
