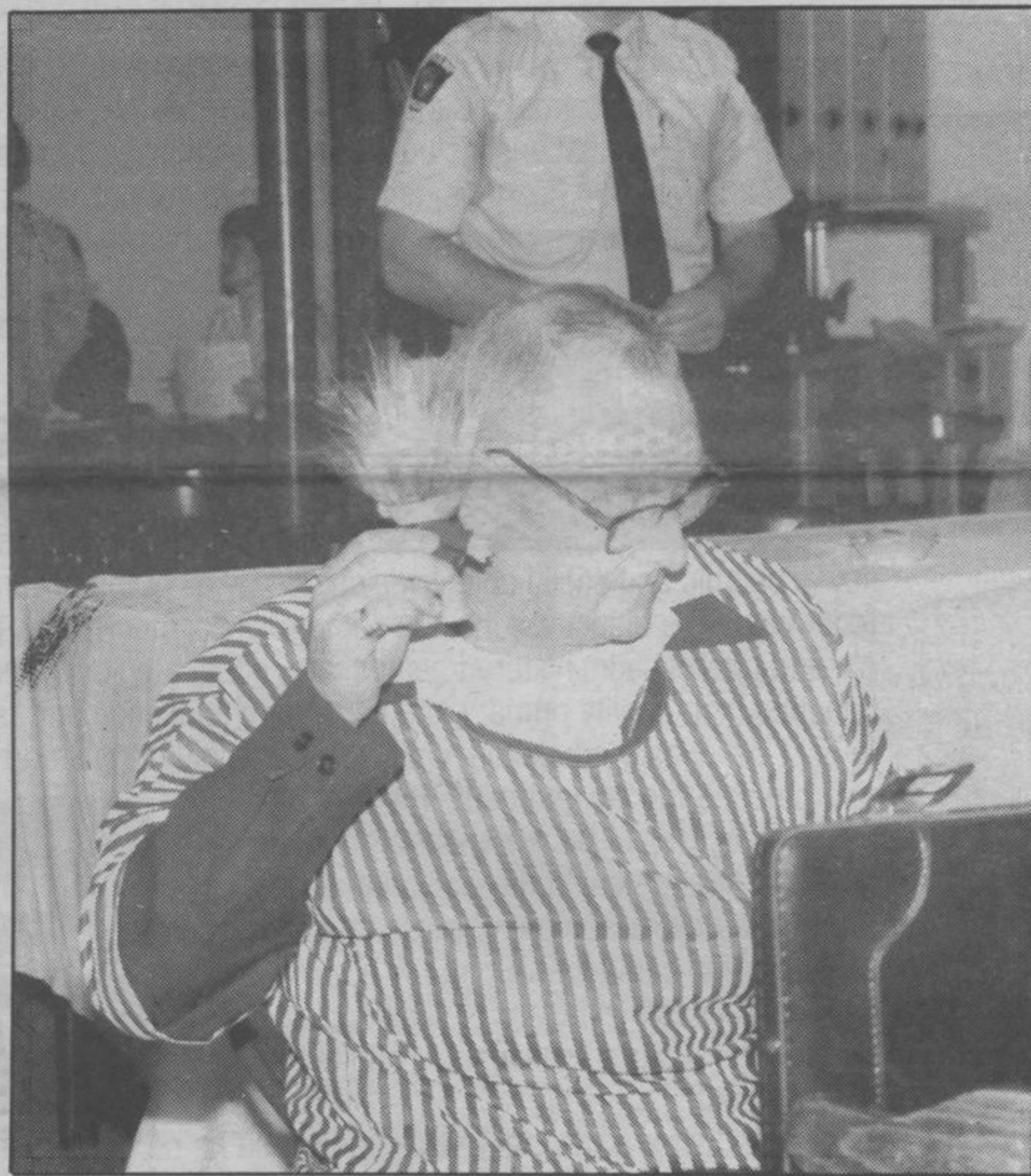
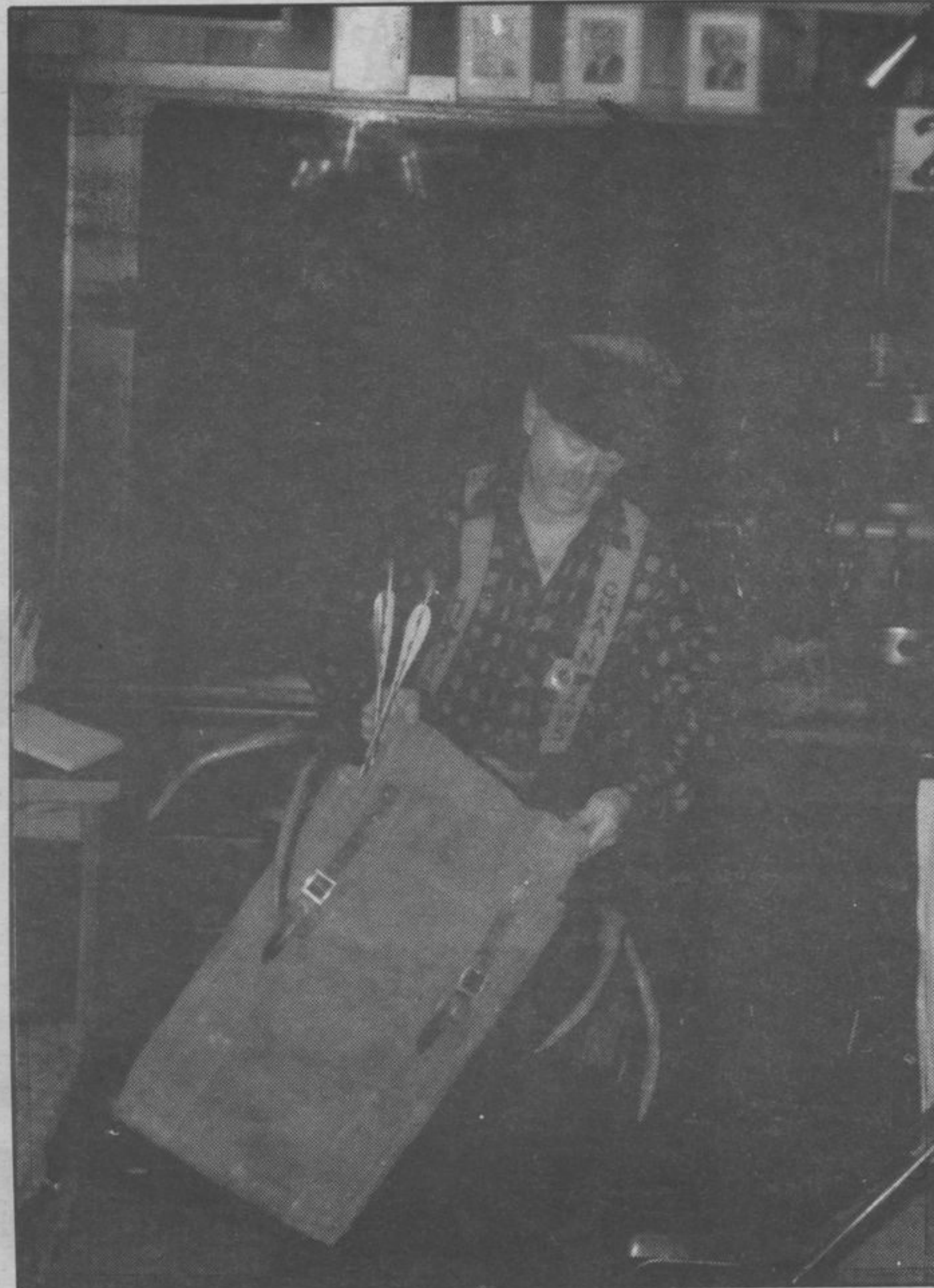


Ex-cons a plenty in Terrace Bay and Schreiber
