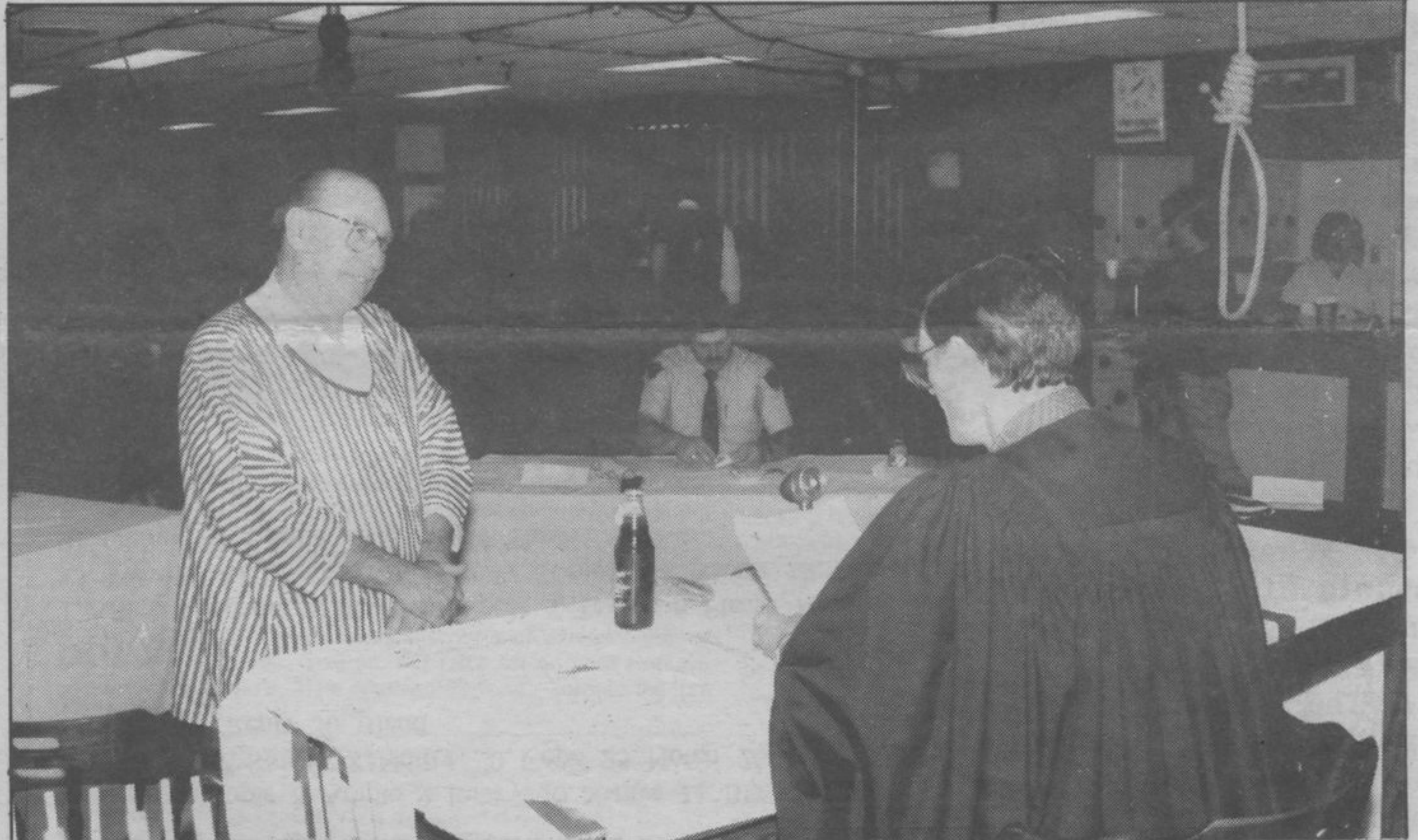


# after first Jail n' Bail in support of McCausland
