tions like the Association across the province. Grants are given for qualifying projects that promote the equality, integration and independence of people with disabilities.

"These community organizations provide vital advocacy, education and support services to people with disabilities," says Elaine Ziemba, Minister of Citizenship with responsibility for Disability Issues. "They need the provinces help, and they're getting it."

"Accessibility in terms of the home, the work place and transportation is one of the most important concerns facing people with disabilities," said Gilles Pouliot, Minister of Transportation and MPP for Lake Nipigon. "I think it's important this region has a group like this focusing attention on issues like these."

The 1992/93 allocation for the Community Action Fund is more than \$1.5 million. The next deadline for application is January 13, 1993.
