

# Medics shut out the opposition at Fort. Erie tourney

There are few things that can top winning the Beaver tournament, but Milton minor atom Docs and Dents probably came as close as you can get with their outstanding late-season performances.

Medics won the Fort Erie tournament after wrapping up the Beaver and they did it without having a goal scored against them. Milton netminders Kevin Gale and Jeff Currie came home sharing the tournament Vezina trophy for shutting out the opposition through five games. Mike Rusk collected the most valuable player award for the entire atom division.

In round-robin action, Milton defeated Welland 2-0, pummelled both Woodstock and Mississauga 7-0, beat Grimsby 4-0 and took the rematch from Welland (3-0) for the championship.

In league play, Medics closed out the regular season with three wins and a loss.

They posted a 25-3 record over the schedule. Medics defeated Brampton 7-3, Streetsville 5-2 and Dundas 4-1. Milton came off on the back end of a 4-0 shutout served up by Flamboro.
