

Jaycees offer baby love seats

If buckling up babies is not a common practice among parents in Milton, it should be once a new Jaycees project catches on. The service club is offering infant "love seats" for rent to parents of newborns. These special restraints retail for \$60 and are used only until the infant is about three months old.

"It's a safety feature that's needed," said chairman of the buckle up baby committee, Jim Bell.

The service club member explained parents may be unwilling to make the investment to buy a seat but if one is available for \$25 they could consider using it. When the love seats are returned \$10 of the rental fee is refunded.

"Once they (babies) are out of these the parents will buy a seat because the child will be using it for two or three years," he said.

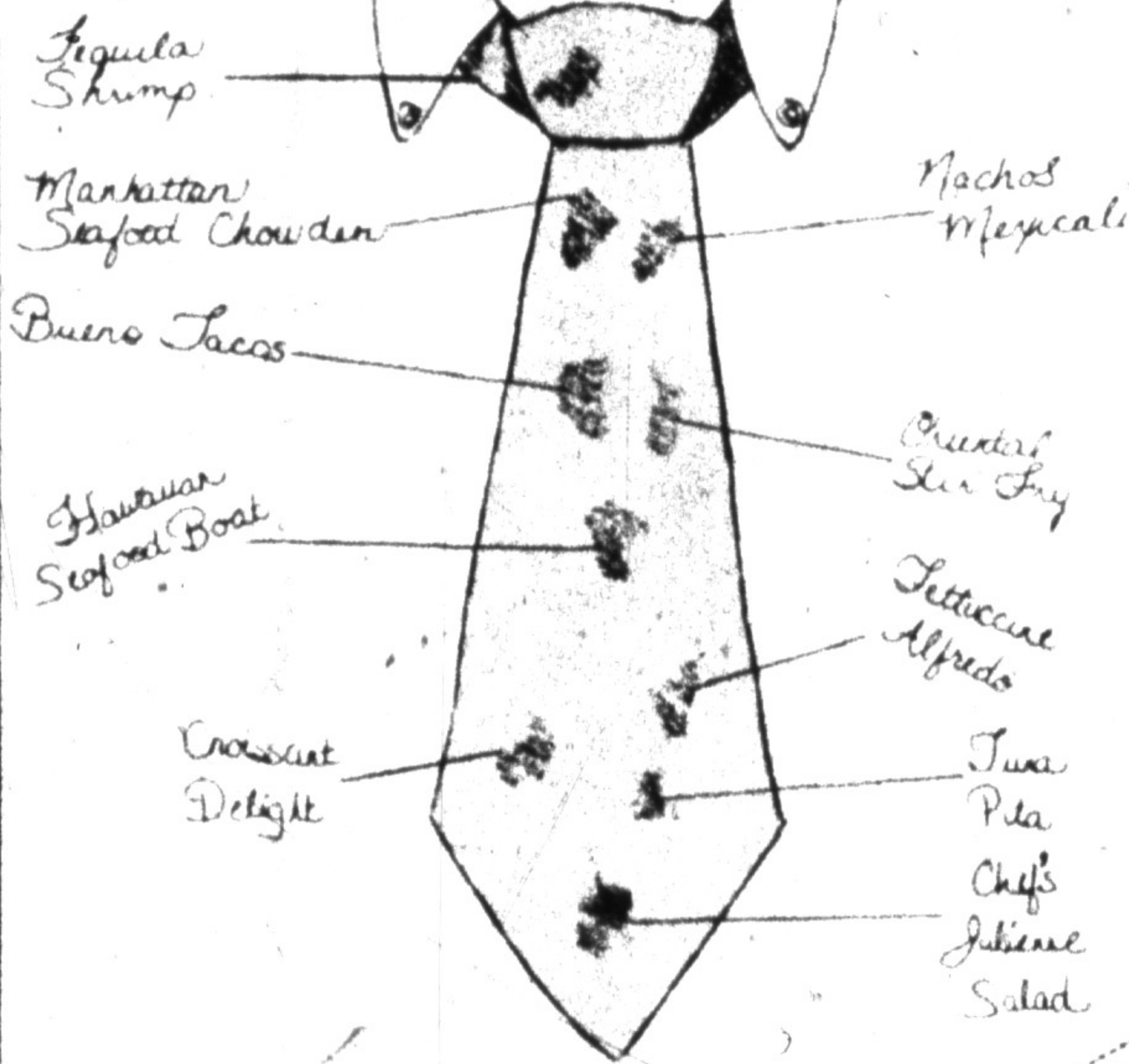
The Jaycees have 10 love seats available for rent and more will be added in the future if there is a demand. Mr. Bell believes once residents become aware of the buckle up baby program more seats will likely be purchased by the Jaycees.

The program is being promoted by the Ontario Safety Council. Through the program this group hopes to get people into the "safety habit." According to the league's statistics, nine children under the age of two were killed in traffic accidents and 401 were injured in 1980.
