his attackers hemmed Burlington in and kept the pressure on. With a minute remaining, Jamie Janjevich scored, assisted by Ian Davidson and Maltais. Maltais got the tying goal seconds later.

Saturday Milton came back from a twogoal deficit to defeat Brampton 3-2. Davidson scored in the second period and Janjevich tied it soon after. In the third period, with less than two minutes remaining, McPhail got the winner.

In tournament action Milton clinched a divisional title at Flamboro over the holidays. Legionaires beat Six Nations 12-2, tied Stoney Creek 3-3, shut out Waterloo 3-0 and edged Dundas 2-1 to gain the champion-ship berth. Milton defeated Preston 4-1 to win the title.






