The Result.

To those who watch the signs of the times the result of the general elections on Tuesday could not have been much of a surprise. For five or six years there have been signs of a breaking up in the Conservative party of the Dominion.

Then the Manitoba school question has for six years been one that promised to disrupt the party ultimately. Mr. McCarthy first split off and worked vigorously as an independent Conservative; next he formed an independent party; lastly he joined to overthrow the Conservatives by any means.

In 1878 the Conservatives won 122 seats to 93 by the Liberals. In 1881 the result was 122 to 92, almost similar. In 1886 the figures are more than reversed, the result being 81 to 177, with about 9 Independents and 3 Patrons.

In 1878 the Conservatives had 68 majority in the House. In 1882, 68. In 1887, 29. In 1891, 30. We congratulate Mr. Burnett upon the success which has attended his first appearance as a politician.

It is pleasant to be able to say after a hot election campaign of two months' duration that not a bitter or unbecoming word was uttered. The candidates in this riding gave each other full credit for the highest qualities as public men.

Premier Taffin, of Quebec, resigned to take the Provincial Legislature under Sir Chas. Tupper. He chose Messrs. Angers Desjardins as Lieutenants in the minority. They were all defeated on Tuesday, and now Mr. Taffin is entirely out of it, premierhip and all.

It is probable that a majority of the people of Canada are in favor of doing ample justice to the Manitoba minority, but are opposed to having it done under the supervision of the bishops. And a singular thing about it is that the French Catholics want wages against their bishops than did the Protestants of Ontario and Manitoba.

Mr. Smith's defeat came about in Oshawa and Cedar Dale, the manufacturing centres of the riding. There was a slump of 103 votes in Oshawa and 58 at Cedar Dale.

Mr. Burnett's majority is less than 140. Thus Mr. Smith was elected in the county if the factory town, those supposed to be interested in the N.P., had stood by him. This is more or less the case all over the Dominion, and is easily accounted for.

The manufacturers were red-hot Tories so long as they had protection, but when they as well as others were asked to contribute towards encouraging the production of raw material in the country they kicked over the traces. They wanted the protection all one way, and grabbed at Mr. Laurier's offer of free raw material.
