The Model Farm. RESULTS OF WINTER WHEAT EXPERIMENTS AT THE ONTARIO AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE, 1897.

Although the comparative order of the yields of these varieties are not the same in 1897 as in the average of four years, still the fact that they gave the largest yields in both cases among all the varieties tested is a very important feature in the experiment.

Large plump seed sown in the autumn of 1896 produced 8 2/3 bushels per acre more than the small plump seed; 6 4/5 bushels per acre more than shrunken seed; and 4 2/3 bushels per acre more than the seed which had been broken with the machine in threshing.

PREVENTION OF SMUT IN WHEAT. An experiment in treating seed wheat for the prevention of smut has been conducted for two years with quite satisfactory results.

DISTRIBUTION OF SEED FOR TESTING PURPOSES. The following three sets of winter wheat varieties will be sent free, by mail in one half pound lots of each variety, to farmers applying for them, who will carefully test the three kinds in the set in which they choose, and will report the results after harvest next year.

SET NO. 1. Dawson's Golden Chaff, Early Genesee Giant, Early Red Clawson.

SET NO. 2. Dawson's Golden Chaff, Prairie of Genesee, Poole.

SET NO. 3. Dawson's Golden Chaff, New Columbia, Imperial Amber.

Each person wishing one of these sets should write to the Experimentalist, Agricultural College, Guelph, mentioning which set he desires; and the grain, with instructions for testing, and the blank form on which to report, will be furnished free of cost to his address until the supply of grain for distributing becomes exhausted.
