Harvesting the Potato Crop.

Owing to the prevalence of the "rot" in the potato crop this season in many sections the work of harvesting is likely to be delayed later than usual.

The potato digger is used in some parts of the country, especially where potatoes are grown extensively. This implement has given good satisfaction, and is increasing in popularity, as it reduces the labor of harvesting to a minimum.

This season it will not be advisable to put the potatoes in the cellar at once. They should be placed in small pits, not more than ten bushels in each, and covered with a liberal supply of straw, with just sufficient soil to keep out the wet.
