

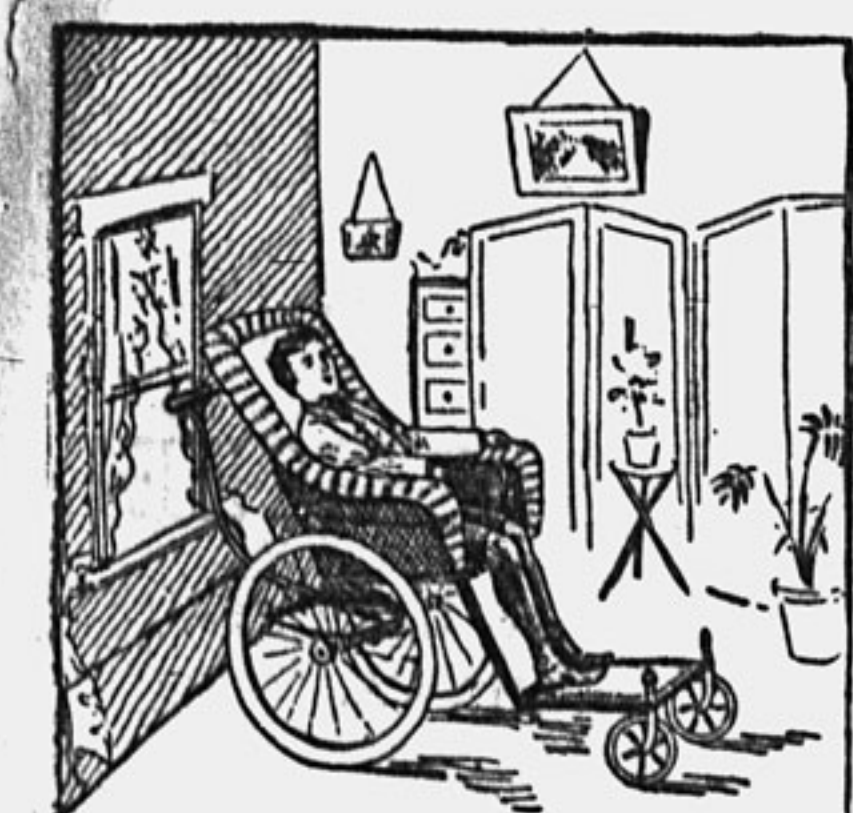
A BOYS SUFFERING.

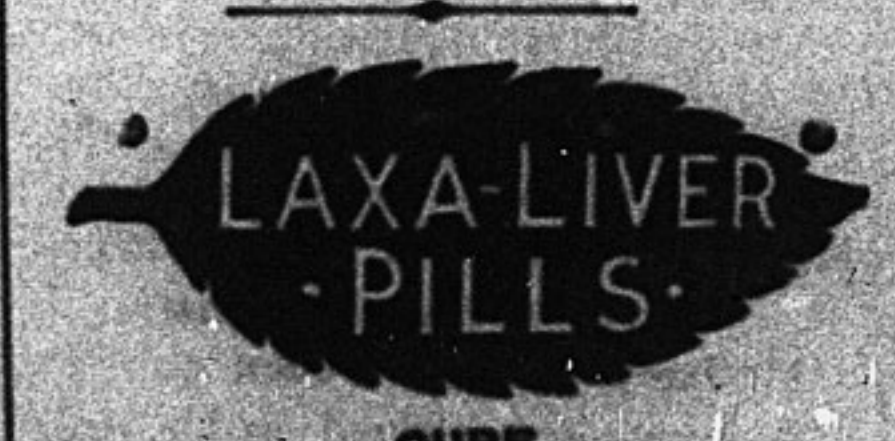
