We then put the calf in a in a pen in the barn its mothers milk as soon as drawn, for a week or ten days; then begin feeding skimmed milk with about a tablespoonful of ground flaxseed scalded by about three or four weeks the ration is composed entirely of skimmed milk and ground flaxseed.

Being placed in the pen with the older calves it soon learns to eat clover hay and grain composed of equal parts of shelled corn, oats and wheat bran, which are fed liberally. We feed the ground flaxseed in preference to oil meal because it contains more fat and is the best substitute for the cream taken from the milk that we have ever tried. After the calf gets to be about ten or twelve weeks old we substitute oil meal for the flaxseed, until the calf is weaned from milk entirely at the age of five or six months and then add the oil-meal to the grain in a dry state. A calf needs its grain ration twice a day for a year at least before it is turned out to grass
