On the 8th of July, 1892, eight of the political convicts who were regarded by the Government for some reason as particularly dangerous, were sent in chains from Kara to St. Petersburg to be imprisoned for life in the "Stone Bays" of Schlusselburg.

They were packed in the middle of July—all the rest of the state criminals were brought back to the political prison at the lower diggings, where they were put into the new and much more comfortable cells, that had been erected by erecting partitions in the original kameras in such a manner as to divide them into thirds.
