Deep in my heart your memory is kept,

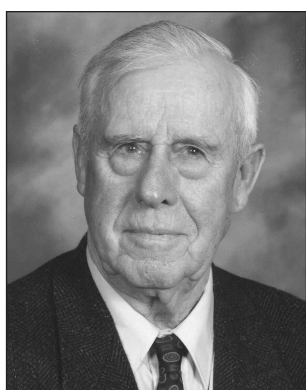

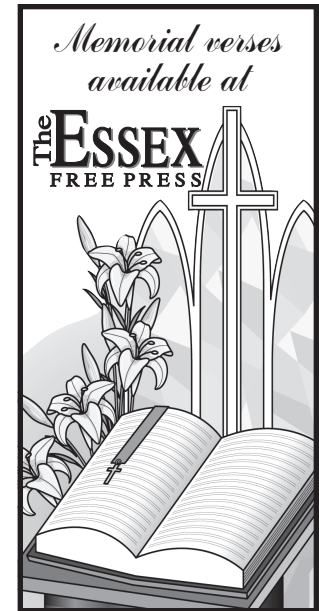
