

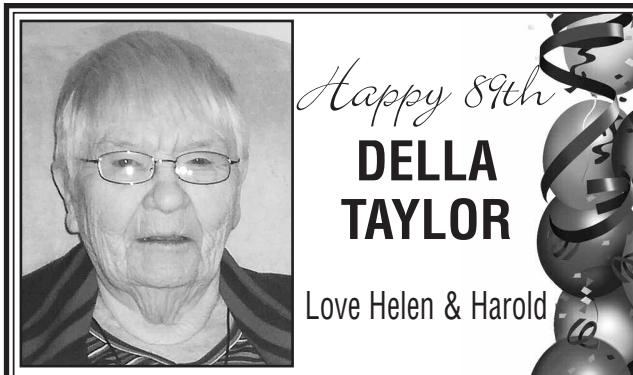
# CELEBRATIONS

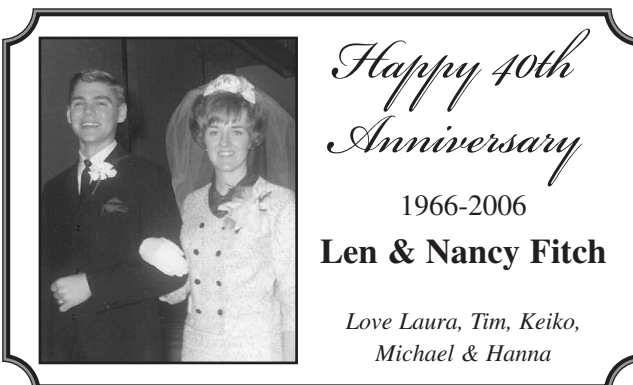
