Caixeiro explains dropout, Garinger files for Ward 1

More developments came this week in preparation for Essex's municipal election.

Ward 3 Councillor Bill Caixeiro told his colleagues on the Essex town council Sept. 5 he pulled out of the municipal election to spend more time with his family.

"It became increasingly clear as we neared the election that for the sake of my wife Nicole, my two daughters Alexandria and Macey and my aging parents, that my focus needed to shift away from my political calling," Caixeiro read.

Caixeiro made the announcement Aug. 28, but didn't give an explanation. He didn't go into details

about his reason at the council meeting, but said he would consider running for council again in the future. He currently sits on the committee of adjustment, the trails and bikeways committee and the harbour committee and is the town's delegate on the ELK Energy board, a member of the county's dog pound committee and an alternate on the Essex-Windsor Solid Waste Authority.

Caixeiro filed nomination papers with the Essex clerk in January.

John Garinger has filed nomination papers with the Essex town clerk to run in the upcoming municipal election Nov. 13.

Garinger filed Sept. 6 to run for councillor in Ward

1. The most recent filing in that ward was from Bill Arps on Aug. 30.

Garinger is a retired teacher with the Greater Essex County District School Board who taught and coached sports at Essex District High School. He was named Citizen of the Year in 2003, was instrumental in building the track at EDHS and is a long-time member of the Royal Canadian Legion in Essex.

"I've been involved in community activism and I thought I'd like to become more involved in a formal way," Garinger said Sept. 11. "I've got more time to spend than other councillors because I'm retired. I think I can donate more time than they can."

Driver's condition upgraded

One of the four people involved in an accident Aug. 19 on Pelee Island has been upgraded to serious condition.

Justin Mullins was driv-

ing a 2003 Chrysler Sebring when he lost control Aug. 19 on Henderson Road, according to a report from the Ontario Provincial Police.

Mullins, and two back seat passengers were airlifted to hospital. The front passenger was treated and released, police said.

An update on the accident released Sept. 8 states that speed was a factor in the collision and that the severity of the injuries could stem from the lack of seat belt use. "The pending Highway Traffic Act charge will not be laid against Justin Mullins due to his long-term injuries," the report states.
