Manning Road to be widened

The provincial and federal governments and the County of Essex jointly announced Sept. 5 funding for a \$7 million project to widen Manning Road between County Road 22 and the VIA Rail line. The road will be widened from two to five lanes.

The project is part of the Let's Get Windsor-Essex Moving strategy.

Canada-Ontario The Border Infrastructure Fund is providing the funding for the strategy, which is a partnership plan by both the provincial and federal gov-
