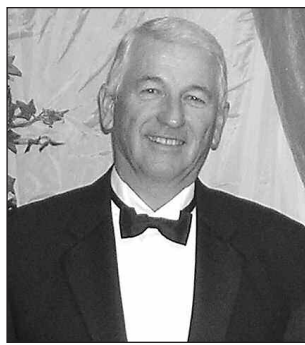


Meet the candidates debate

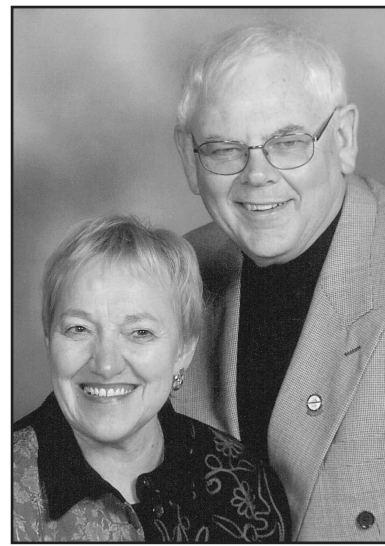
NOTICE OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS
