The Essex District High School girls' hockey team is experiencing the game in an entirely new way, said club manager Margaret Malenfant-Bosse.

This season, local girls' hockey officially became a WECSSAA-sanctioned school sport, which Malenfant-Bosse calls "a major breakthrough" for the game.

"This is exciting and more organized - it's an official league now," she said. "We can compete for SWOSSAA and OFSSA now, which is the first year the girls have had that opportunity and that's what makes it such a major year."

Malenfant-Bosse, who's managed the team for the past four seasons, said previously the Essex club combined players with

As interest among local schools grew, a group of coaches was able to raise 11 teams from Windsor and Essex County to form an official, no-contact league.

Now, EDHS has its 18player team and will compete in a 10-game season against local schools of all

The team also competed in a tournament hosted by Belle River High School last month.

"There is talent on our team," Malenfant-Bosse said. "That's including the brand new rookie players. The thing that impressed me the most about our girls is their stamina. The game

Malenfant-Bosse said one thing she's noticed in the four years she's managed the club is that players are bringing more experience to the team.

Malenfant-Bosse said the coaching staff, made up of her husband Mark as head coach and her son Michael as trainer, try to mix up the lines so experienced girls are playing with rookies.
