

Large theft of metal in Amherstburg

On Thursday Feb. 22, 2007 a number of large feed screws and shelves were reported missing from I.D.O.D. Ltd. which is located at 7091 Smith Industrial Drive in Amherstburg. These items

were last observed outside the industrial plant on or about Feb. 13, 2007.

The items are extremely heavy and it is obvious that they would have been moved by a large truck and by more than one person.

The total value of the stolen items is approximately \$200,000. It is possible that the culprits may try to sell these items as scrap metal.
