Clara was a 60 yr. member of the CWL at Holy Name of Jesus Church, a member of the Essex Retirees and a long-time member of the St.

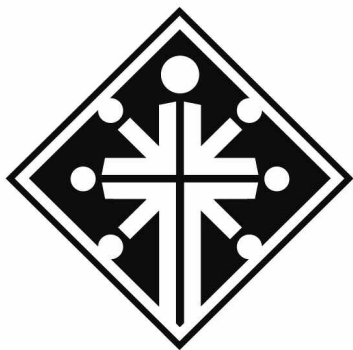
