Essex eliminates Peach Kings in quadruple overtime

For the third consecutive season the Essex 73's will be off to the show – the Ontario Junior "C" championship.

Essex eliminated the stingy Grimsby Peach Kings in a four-game sweep, but it was far from easy. All four games were determined by a single goal (game one final was 4-2, which included an empty net goal), with the fourth and final game going into a seventh period before the Essex victory.
