County Council.
 (Condensed from the Meaford Mirror.)
THURSDAY.
 Owen Sound Hospital asked for a grant of \$300 and Walters Falls Ag. Society asked for \$75. Referred to Finance committee.
 Mr. Gordon presented report No. 1 of Road and Bridge com. This report dealt with the application of J. Hickling and others, with reference to opening town line, Osprey & Artemesia. The Clerk was instructed to notify the councils of the townships interested to give the petitioners relief as speedily as possible. A similar matter being Artemesia & Euphrasia was dealt with. The Clerk was directed to call the attention of the councils interested to their statutory position in reference to this matter, and in the event of their failing in their duty, the Warden and G. A. Brown were appointed a com. on behalf of the county council to enquire into and adjust the matter. Clause three appointed Messrs Binnie and McKinnon a special committee to look after the necessity of the building of a new bridge on the coline opposite Bentinck Tp.
 Report of Co. Property com. dealt with the payment of several accounts for repairs, etc., to county buildings, which were ordered to be paid. The chairman was instructed to advertise for a supply of stone for jail yard operations. It also instructed a special committee to see about cost of a new roof for court house, to report next session.
 Printing acts were recommended for payment as follows: Jas. H. Little, \$23.25; J. H. Rutherford, \$2; Alex. Santer, \$1.50; H. E. Glending, \$35.00; Sun Printing Co., \$7.75.
 Mr. Binnie presented report No. 2 of Finance committee, and on motion it was adopted. It recommended a refund of License fee paid by the late Jas Galbraith as auctioneer; also that the sum of \$200 be granted to the General and Marine Hospital. It recommended the granting of \$200 to each of the District Agricultural Societies of the county, but declined to recommend a grant to the Walters Falls Central Society.
 Mr. Bishop presented report No. 1 of Education com. which was adopted. It recommended the filing of the reports of South, West and East Grey Inspectors of Schools, and that the vacancy on O. S. School Board be filled.

FRIDAY.
 Members all present except Mr. Gordon who was away as a witness at court. Minutes read etc. Printing acts of A. M. Rutherford referred to com. Mr. Binnie presented report No. 3 of Finance, which was subsequently adopted. It provided for the appointment of Mr. Henry M. Douglas, of Vandeleur, as county student to O. A. C. It also took up the county treasurer's estimate for 1899, and dealt with it as follows:
