



As a rule carrots are not treated respectfully either by cook or diners. Yet they are a wholesome vegetable, capable of being made into a delicious one, if they but fall into clever hands.

CARROTS.

A few receipts to this end may be of service to the housewife, who is often hard pressed for variety even in preparing her vegetables and a salad for her simple dinner, and who heretofore has only thought of carrots as the golden slice in vegetable soup or accompaniment of a pin bone stew.

method of preparing caris in this wise: Take several bunches of small carrots and plunge them into boiling water for five minutes; then rub the outer peel off with a clean cloth. This is considered a better way than scraping them. Cut off the green tops and cut the carrots into thin slices. Put into a sauce pan three ounces of butter, two tablespoonfuls of water, a saltspoonful of salt, a little pepper and the sliced carrots. Cover the pan and stew slowly for therty minutes. Meanwhile beat light the yolk of two eggs, and add to them half a cup of cream and one tablespoonful of chopped parsley. Pour this sauce over the cooked carrots, and let them remain over the fire long enough to cook, and then serve immediately.

The French manner of cooking very young carrots is delicious. Boil them until tender, then cut them in halves lengthwise. Melt some butter in a hot spider and when the butter bubbles, lay in the carrots and sprinkle them with some sugar, salt and pepper, and finely chopped parsley. Fry them until the edges become crisp and browned. Lyonnaise carrots are made in

the same way, only cooking some finely chopped onion in the melted butter before adding tthe vegetables. To make creamed carrots, put in a saucepan two tablespoonfuls of butter,

and when it is melted stir in one spoonful of flour. Gradually add to this one cup of rich milk, and season with pepper and salt. Cut the boiled carrots into cubes or

with a small scoop into small balls, and stir them into the creamed sauce. When hot turn them into a heated dish, sprinkle chopped parsley over them and serve.

A delicious entree is made thus: Scrape and cut into cubes enough carrots to make one quart. Put these into a saucepan containing three pints of boiling water, and cook until they are nearly tender. Then drain off all the water, and add one cup of stock, a teaspoonfal of sugar and some salt and pepper. Cool rapidly until the stock has been almost boiled away, add a large tablespoonful of butter, and shake the pan so that the butter and remaining liquid will mix and adhare to the carrots, coating them. Pile the carrots in the centre of a hot platter and serve with small fritters placed around the edge of the

platter. For pickled carrots, cut them into cubes or balls and cook them until tender but not soft. Put them in a jar and cover with hot vinegar, to which has been added a sliced onion, a few peppercorns, some celery seed and a couple of bay leaves. This pickle is very nice for serving with cold meats or using with beets to garnish potato salad.

DEATH IN THE POT.

The use of enamelled iron ware for culinarly purposes is becoming households possess one or more of these articles, which have much to recommend them on the score of ease in cleansing, and the rapidity with which heat penetrates to the contents. Mr. Sharpin, F. R. C. S., of Brighton, has, however, called our attention to this latter property, and shown that it may constitute a source of danger, says the British Medical Journal. He met with the case of a cook, who, in cleaning a saucepan made of this ware, had been pierced with a small piece of the enamel under the finger-nail Upon examination after extraction, the fragment proved to be like glass in appearance and sharpness. He points out how readily this enamel breaks off from the subjacent iron, if it be submitted too rapidly to a great heat. This he attributes to the rapid expansion of the metal without a corresponding extension of the enamel. Once cracked, moisture obtains access to the iron, which becomes rusty and the enamel then peels off in small flakes or large pieces. Mr. Sharpin ascertained that it was very difficult to pick these pieces out of certain vegetables, for example, spinach or cabbage, and draws the inference that many people eat food to which particles of enamel are adherent. He then inquires whether, such being the case, this may not account for the greater frequency of certain in testinal troubles at the present day than in the days before enamelled
