For example, were Russia to annex the Slavs in the northern part of the empire, the Slavs of Croatia, would still remain an isolated fragment, separated from the others by Germans and Magyars; and Germany could not annex the main bodies of the German population without including Bohemia and so isolating the Czechs of that kingdom. Indeed the more the question is studied, the more apparent it becomes that the races of the Austro-Hungarian Empire would not seek their ethnic affinities elsewhere, and that the states surrounding them could not or would not, compel them to, attack by Italy to gain the Italian provinces, leaving her again at the mercy of France, and attack by Germany or Russia being certain to bring on a general war. The maintenance of Austrian unity is, in fact, so neessary to the peace and progress of Surope, and to the happiness of the peoples and races within the empire itself, that despite the gloomy predictions made, the arrangement securing it is likely to last a pretty long time.




