Russia has won in the contest for a site for a coaling station and naval hospital at Masampo, in Korea, thus marking another step toward the completion of her strategic defences against any power that may dispute her paramountcy in North China and the Hermit Kingdom.

England being preoccupied elsewhere, she has secured a naval base on the southern coast of the Korean peninsula which will prevent her sea route between Vladivostok and Port Arthur from being cut off by Japan, which holds the opposite side of the Korean Straits, and has fortified the island of Tsushima.

As it is improbable that Japan can follow England's example, and live by the expansion of her manufactures, because of the lack of capital, and because the market which she might have found in northern China and Manchuria promises to be cut off by Russia, some cultivatable overseas territory must be found for her surplus population.

HINTS FOR THE FARMER.

KEEP COWS BY THEMSELVES.

I wish to emphasize the fact that young calves should be kept separate from other domestic animals, both in the stable and pasture. This is not a matter of sentiment, but of practical business, as by thus doing more and better milk will be obtained.

In the first place the bleating of young calves distresses their mothers, and causes the milk flow to become erratic. They should be kept in another building, entirely separate from the cow stable, out of sight and sound.

Farmers carrying on mixed stock raising as well as general agriculture are apt to keep all kinds of cattle in the common pasture, to the detriment of dairy interests.
