

Prohibition Resolutions.

The following are some of the resolutions that were affirmed at the Convention of the Dominion Alliance held in Toronto last week :

Regret that no legislation has been introduced in fulfilment of the prom ises of the Government and in response to the overwhelming demand of the electorate as expressed in the referendum.

That the minimum of legislation that can be accepted as ressonable and right would be the abolition of the public bar, the treating system and drinking in clubs, etc.

That it is the duty of temperance men to work for the nomination and election of candidates pledged to the immediate enactment of the legislation asked for by the alliance, and that either political party definitely declaring itself in favor of such a policy, that party would be endorsed by the electors at the polls.

That this convention cordially ap proves the action of the executive in the forming of Voters' Leagues, as an effective way of securing the en actment and enforcement of the legislation that has been demanded.


