

A bright airy cellar, or a well ventilated room having an even temperature is the best place. The ventilation should be so arranged that there will be outside air entering the room at all times, but without a direct draught blowing on the machine.

Finally, let me repeat the advice Somebody's child. to follow implicitly the directions that accompany the machine. Study the weak. The Hospital pays out divicarefully the instructions regarding the care of the lamp and the control of temperature, the turning, cooling and testing of the eggs, and all other details. Then, when hatching commences let the machine alone. It is too late to rectify mistakes in management, and interference can only injure the hatch. The chicks should be left in the machine until they are thoroughly dry, and should not be fed the first day. When feeding commences be careful to feed sparingly. 
