**THE EARTH SHOOK LIKE SHIP AT SEA**  
Mountains Heaved and Swayed For Nearly a Minute  
(Toronto News)

Calcutta, April 6.—Reports from many towns show widespread damage and more fatalities in the earthquake of April 4. This is especially the case at Firepur, 47 miles south east of Lahore, Amritsar, Trana, Dehra Dun and Srinagar, at which places many natives were killed or injured. At Lahore the fatalities were between fifty and one hundred.

Personal stories from Mussoree state that the mountains heaved and swayed a full minute, and then three severe shocks, each lasting a few seconds, were felt in quick succession. Between 6 a. m. on April 4 and midnight there were twelve shocks. The day was fine and clear and most of the inhabitants were already up when the first shock came. Those who were still in bed described the motion as being that of a ship in a storm, while those on foot could not maintain their balance.

Many narrow escapes are reported. The effect of the shock in sickness and dizziness with many still continues. Many persons sat or slept out of doors during the whole of last night.

**FOUND WITH THROAT CUT**  
Just as we go to press this (Wednesday) evening we learn that Geo. Strong, son of Wm. Strong of 6th con., was found by his brother John lying in a bedroom with his throat cut. Geo. resided on his own farm and was a bachelor, living alone and no cause can be assigned as yet for the act and whether it was an attempt of suicide or murder is hard to say as nothing can be found as will establish anything definite in either case. Dr. Whitney and Coronor Smale were immediately summoned, and it is very doubtful if they will be able to bring him around again.
