E. E. Knott says of the cotton market: "The general opinion is faithless and indifferent, for on the one hand the bulls have been doing nothing but following misleading information and on the other hand so loud has been the proclamation of good trade demand and famine supplies of the spinners and exporters, it has made the ordinary bear timid.

"My opinion is to attempt a bull movement with the world's stocks over 5,000,000 bales, and receipts continuing on a scale insuring a 11,000,000 bale crop and the price three cents per pound higher than a year ago.

"I advise selling on to-day's level or any further advance, believing it will show a very handsome profit in the near future."
