Town Has The Option.

It has been a well known fact for some years that the woollen mills business has not been a profitable one owing to the high price of wool and the stiff competition of large mills, and the Hanover factory along with many others has been losing money year after year. This year there was a general feeling among directors and shareholders that it would be wiser to close up the factory and realize whatever possible. This was done and on Tuesday of this week a meeting was held in Telford's hall by the shareholders to confirm the sale of the building, water rights etc of the Hanover Woollen Mills Co. for \$4000 cash, a private party making that offer for same. The shareholders refused the offer, however, and authorized the directors to give an option to the town of Hanover to purchase for \$4500 said property covering three months for the sum of \$100. With this end in view no doubt the necessary by-law will be submitted to a vote of the ratepayers as speedily as possible.

NAMING THE BABY.
