#### SHEEP SCAB.

How to Know Disease and How to

Cause.-The disease is caused by a mite which pricks the skin of the sheep, causing a scab to form under which the mite lives.

Symptoms. - The animal is restless. They scratch and bite themselves and rub against fences, etc. The Flipper-If you are dissatisfied fleece looks tufted or matted and sheep with its mouth. If the hand is held to the sheep's nose while it is being scratched the animal will commense nibbling. This is one sure symptom of the disease.
