Farm Drainage Demonstrations.

The Department of Physics at the Ontario Agricultural College desires to announce the continuance of its previous offer of assistance to farmers in matters pertaining to drainage. For the past three years we have been authorized by the Minister of Agriculture to go out and assist any farmers in making the levels of his lands for drainage purposes, in planning the most advantageous systems of drains, and in calculating the grades and sizes of tile for the different drains. A finished map bearing all the information is sent to the owner.
