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AROUND THE FARM.

Busy hens are not only the best egg producers, but their eggs show the best fertility. In order to keep them at work strew the floor of the pen with hay or straw and scatter the grain in this.

Another word about the chicks in regard to early brooding. Get them to roost as early as possible. Do not make rough roosting piles. The smoother they are the easier it is to keep them free from lice.

Given good care, just sensible care, as common sense will ordinarily dictate, poultry will return a good profit on the time and money expended thereon.

Make arrangements for fattening all birds, either cockerels or old hens, before they are marketed. If you have not a feeding crate or two, rig up an old packing box, or better still have a good solid crate which will last you for years.

One of the recent regular monthly tests in the Innerkip, Ont., Cow-testing Association, showed that 160 cows gave an average yield of 833 pounds of milk, testing 3.4, thus containing 34.6 pounds fat.

Another district averaged only 664 pounds milk per cow, while in a herd the average was 662 pounds. Some herds were as low as 412 pounds milk, 13 1/2-2 pounds fat, as an average of nine cows.
