When making tomato catsup put the spices in a bag and you cut-up will look like what you buy. Always put the ground spices in a bag for any kind of pickles, and they will not be discolored. When making boiled salad dressing, or custard of any kind, if it curdles, remove from fire, and beat with the egg beater and it will be all right in a moment. When baking a crust for lemon pie, turn pie tin over, and put crust on the outside of tin, bake as usual; and you have a perfect crust. The flaky part is outside, and the crusty part inside, so it will not soak.
