The call of Matthew, the first part of today's lesson, is found in Matthew and Luke, as well as in Mark. But the rest of the lesson, including Matthew's entertainment, and the parables of the new and old cloth and the new and old wine are found only as these: "I can of mine ownself do nothing." "The Father who sent Me gave me a commandment, what I should say and what I should speak." "The Father who dwelleth in me, He doeth the works" (John v, 30; xil, 49; xiv, 10). His compassion upon the multitude and His readiness to teach them, no matter how weary He was, is our example that we may follow His steps in this as well as in His meekness and patience (I Pet. ii, 21). Then He told them what true fasting in His sight was (Zech. vii, 4-10; Isa. lviii, 6-10). Note how He speaks of Himself as the Bridegroom and His disciples as the children of the bride chamber, no doubt looking onward to the marriage of the Lamb of Rev. xix. We might well ask: Where is now the fasting because of the Bridegroom's absence? Where are those who long for His return, who rejoice greatly because of His voice, glad to decrease if only He may increase? (John iii, 29, 30.)
