COLONEL ASTOR THE MILLIONAIRE

Career of the New York Soldier Who Went Down With the Titanic

Col. John Jacob Astor, who until he went down with the Titanic was the head of the family in the States, was born at Ferncliffe, the country home of his father at Rhinebeck on the Hudson, in 1836.

As manager of the Astor estate Col. Astor began extensive building operations. On his property at Fifth avenue and Thirty-fourth street he started the construction of the Astoria Hotel, adjoining the Waldorf, erected by his cousin, William Waldorf Astor.

Col Astor was a director in many financial institutions and railroads. Besides being a business man and an inventor he was the author of two books, "A Journey in Other Worlds" and "A Romance of the Future."

His Marriage He married Miss Ava L. Willing of Philadelphia in 1891. They took up their residence at 840 Fifth avenue, adjoining his mother's house.

Last September Col. Astor married Miss Madeleine Force, the twenty-year-old daughter of William H. Force, a shipping merchant.

Col. Astor, like his father and unlike his grandfather, was fond of the sea. Most of his yachting was done on the Nourmahal, the immense steam yacht built for his father.

Money for Both the Wives It is understood that following the Astor custom Col. John Jacob Astor made a marriage settlement of cash and securities on both of his wives, they in turn giving up their dower rights in the estate.
