
THE IMPORTED PURE-BRED CLYDESDALE STALLION

Bred by Fred Porter, Doddington, Wooler, Northumberland, England; imported August 1912 by Graham Bros., Claremont, Ont. Black, face, front of nigh hind ankle and leg, off hind ankle and front of leg white, spots on front of fore legs, born April 12, 1909, will make the season of 1924, health and weather permitting, as follows:

MONDAY, will leave his own stable, Lot 32, Concession 9, Bentinck, and proceed to Harry Williams' for noon, thence to Albert Kleist's, Con. 6, Glenelg for night.

ROYAL CADET is a splendid, big-sized, dark-colored horse of great gaiety and style, with the best quality of feet, legs, and ankles, good, clean, sharp bones, and beautiful close, straight action. It will be seen from his pedigree that he is exceptionally well bred on both sides. On the one side he is a great grandson of both Baron's Pride and Moss Rose, and on the other side he is a great grandson of Baron's Pride, Macgregor and Lord Ailsa, so that there is in him the choicest blood. He is a horse of superb quality and has proven himself a popular and profitable stock-getter. His sire, Montrave Matador, is a son of the celebrated Baron o' Buchlyvie (11,263), out of Montrave Mermaid (14,224), by Prince of Albion (6178); grand-dam Moss Rose (6203), by the Dunmore Prince Charlie (634), &c. His dam, Eileen Alanna, is a mare of very superior quality and breeding, and a prize-winner at the Scottish-English border shows. Her sire, Historian, is a son of that unique champion, Baron's Pride, out of Duchess of Robgill (11,940), by Macgregor (1487); grand-dam, Mary of Threave (4911), by the old Auchleach Tom (877), &c.
