FAT STOCK SHOW

The first winter Fat Stock, Poultry and Horticultural Exhibition was held in Toronto last week, and was pronounced a great success. It is conducted on lines similar to those that have been held in Guelph for many years, and it is thought the better accommodation for man and beast in Toronto would cause a change in the place near future to be made in the place of holding these winter fairs. There was a very large exhibit of poultry and domestic birds of all kinds, but birds of plumage didn't seem to be up to former years in Guelph.

The horticultural show was a magnificent display, and far beyond our powers of description. Grey county had a fine apple exhibit, but for a unique display there was nothing to touch the county of Peel. This gave a representation of the whole county laid out in apples, showing all the towns, villages, hamlets, and the good roads, railroads, and every detail necessary in a good map. Where the Hydro-electric power is used was represented by a line of electric lamps. The location of some of the leading fruit farms was also pictured. The whole display was much admired by the spectators.

Large exhibits of horses, sheep, cattle and swine were also to be found, and every stall in the dog-house had its occupant. We have no idea how many dogs there were but they must have run up into the hundreds, and included every conceivable variety.

The attendance, we learn, was not sufficient to make it profitable and the Exhibition grounds, had thronged at Exhibition time, had a very deserted appearance. There was no crowding, no midway noise. Everybody had lots of room. It was like "The Deserted Village."
