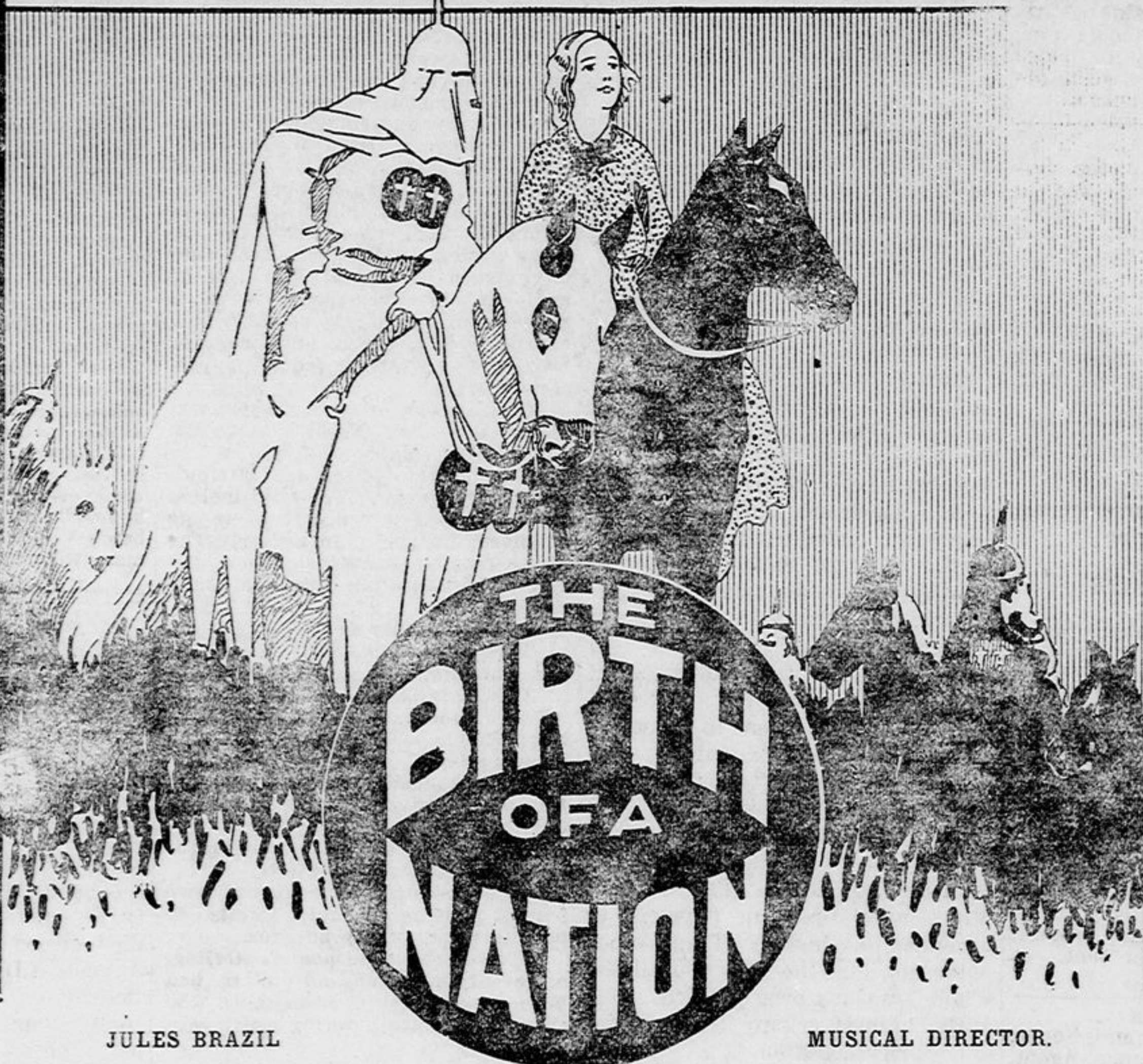

DR. MICHAEL CLARK CHOSEN BY RED DEER DISTRICT. riding flocked to Red Deer this afternoon to hear the name of Dr. Michael Clark put in nomination at a Win-the-War convention by his former Conservative opponent, J. F. Day. The convention was held in the Red Deer Federal the Armory building, attendance be-

ing equally divided between the two parties.

In a powerful speech preceding the nomination, Dr. Clark explained his refusal to accept a straight Liberal nomination recently on the ground that he was standing in the same position which Laurier had occupied at the beginning of the war. He quoted his former leader's words on that occasion to the effect that he (Laurier) would offer no criticism of the Government during the war as long as danger faced the allies at the front, even though the Government might commit some act subject to criticism. "That is my attitude to-day," declared Dr. Clark to the convention. "But I defy Laurier to say it is still his." Dr. Clark's speech throughout was a strong plea for support of the Union Government in the hour of Canada's trial.

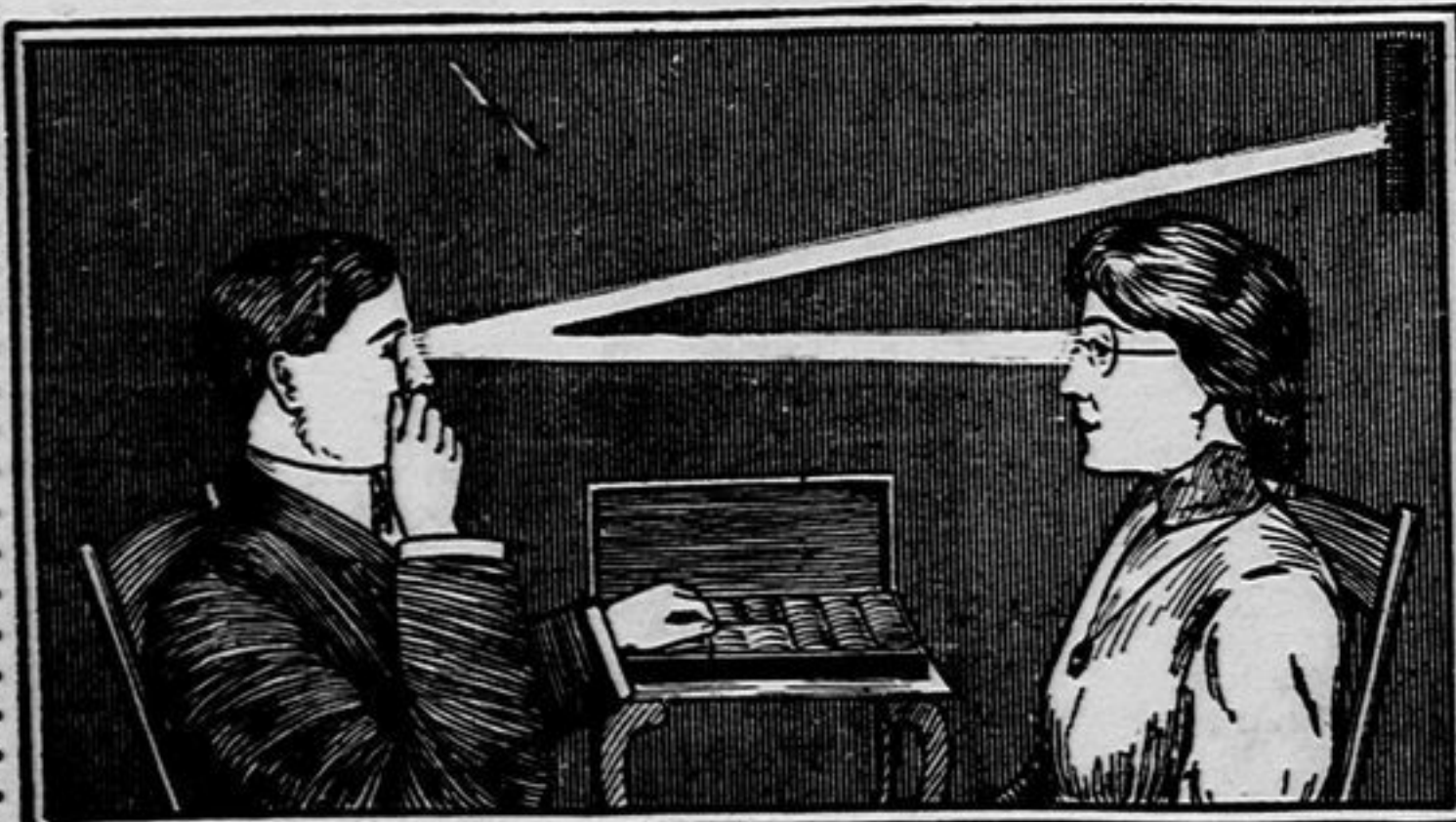
