ACCIDENTS INCREASING AT LEVEL CROSSINGS

Number Has Doubled in Past Six Months, Railway Officials State. Motorists Fail To Exercise Due Precaution.

The growing frequency of level crossing accidents is such as to have made the matter one for tabulation and for serious concern amongst railway officials.

Chief Claims Agent J. W. Scheinhof of the Canadian Pacific Railway stated last evening that his road had recorded 17 level crossing accidents in the district about Toronto since October last, and that two had occurred only last Friday.

Mr. Scheinhof stated that the reason for the increase in the number of accidents was not to be found in any increase in train traffic, since there had been none.
