REVISED BAGGAGE RULES FOR RAILWAY TRAVELLERS

Dogs, cats, baby carriages, airplanes, airships and commercial travellers samples figure in the revised regulations governing baggage car traffic just issued by the Dominion Railway Board.

Any dog of value not exceeding \$25 and not intended for show purposes will be accepted as baggage to be paid at the regular rate.

Baby carriages and other children's vehicles, when used in connection with the journey, will be accepted as baggage subject to charge at the regular rate provided.

Three hundred pounds is the limit of samples and free baggage for any traveller who is a member of a Canadian Commercial Travellers' Association and 150 lbs. the limit for a commercial traveller not a member of such organization.

HOW A FARMER CAN GO BROKE

The agricultural college of the University of Tennessee suggests ten ways for a man to go broke farming. They are as follows:

- 1. Grow only one crop. 2. Keep no live stock. 3. Regard chickens and a garden as nuisance. 4. Take everything from the soil and return nothing. 5. Don't stop gullies or grow cover crops—let the top soil wash away, then you will have "bottom" land. 6. Don't plan your farm operations. It's hard work thinking—trust to luck. 7. Regard your woodland as you would a coal mine; cut every tree sell the timber and wear the cleared land out cultivating it in corn and cotton. 8. Hold fast to the idea that the methods of farming employed by your grandfather are good enough for you. 9. Be independent—don't join with your neighbors in any form of co-operation. 10. Mortgage your farm for every dollar it will stand to buy things you would have the cash to buy if you followed a good system of farming.
