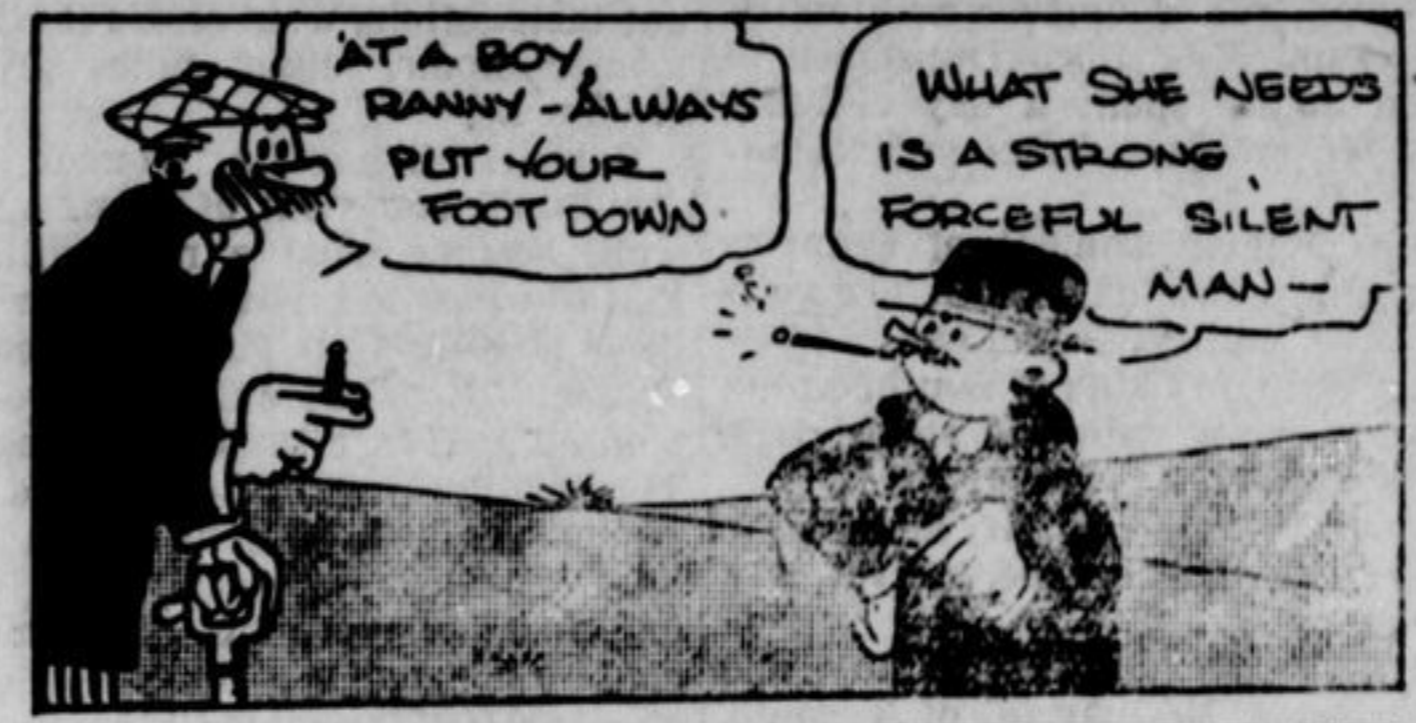

WILLIAM THE CONQUEROR A SUCCESSFUL BANDIT

As we read of him in our school histories, William the Conqueror seemed a great king and warrior, but viewed through the eyes of modern inquirers he seems a less worthy personage, and Miss Sarah Henry Benton, who has recently concluded a critical survey of the king and his times, shows that he was a bandit. What would have been the course of our British history had William the Conqueror never won the Battle of Hastings it is idle to speculate.
