The city of Toronto does not produce half the students who attend the Provincial University. According to the President's report, just issued, 2,631 students came from the city last year, and the total registration was 5,986.

Manufacturers are not far behind. Their sons and daughters to the number of 81 entered the first year. The clerical staff of Ontario are represented by 76 entrants; physicians and surgeons, 60; teachers, 59; business managers, 51; transportation men, 48; lawyers, 44; insurance and real estate men, 40; wholesale merchants, 30; financial men, 29; engineers, 28; journalists, 21; and dentists, 16.
